Welcome to the Old Colony Ski Club!

We have prepared this welcome guide to assist you to get to know the lodge, and to help you be comfortable during your stay with us. Your host will help you by showing you the ropes but you can use this as a reminder if you have questions:

Check in. Please visit the dorm floor (Women -2nd floor, Men -3rd floor) and select a room for your stay, noting the letter over the door. To show that your chosen bunk is taken you should place your bags and sleeping bag on the bunk then proceed to the check-in desk.

At the check-in desk there are three things we ask you to do upon arrival: a) Put your name on the bunk sheet in the appropriate room, b) enter your name on the roster, the night(s) you are staying and the amount owed (\$25/night for guests), and c) place your cash or check in one of the small envelopes of the left side of the desk and deposit it in the silver box next to the door.

The kitchen is equipped with gas stove/oven and griddle. Burners should light if turned to the full "on" position. If the pilot light does not light the burner or oven, blow gently on the burner, keeping clear of the flames!

There is a gorgeous fireplace in the lounge area. Please ask a member to light the fire if one is not burning.

There are several light switches in the lounge and dining areas. The lounge lights are located near the red door on the right as you enter. The dining area switches are located to the left of the louvered doors to the utility room. The kitchen lights are to the left as you enter.

There are two fire escapes in addition to doors in the kitchen, dining area, lower porch and upper porch. The second floor escape is at the end of the women's bunkroom hallway. The third floor escape is accessed through room K on the men's floor. We ask that the fire escape exits remain closed except in case of an emergency.

There are fire extinguishers located: Kitchen – near refrigerator; Dining – next to door; Lounge – next to door; Women's – next to entrance; Men's – top of stairs, end of hall.

Please be sure that the doors are closed securely behind you when leaving the building.

We want your stay with us to be as enjoyable and comfortable as possible. If you have any questions, please just ask a member or the Director in Charge, whose name is posted on the whiteboard in the dining area.
